Reception children will be very tired as they start to have full days in school and Nursery children will be getting used to coming every day. Risk Assessment

As you are aware, we have an updated risk assessment for Covid-19. This is also on the school website. We have been working hard to make the classrooms as inviting as possible whilst keeping everyone safe. The children will have a smaller selection of toys to play with so they can be cleaned regularly. The children do not need to socially distance but we will be encouraging them to wash their hands more often and use tissues. Parents are not allowed to bring children into school at the moment and please remember to socially distance when waiting in the playground.

P.E.

We go over to the hall for our class P.E. sessions. We will be working with Coach David every Thursday morning. Children do not need to bring any shoes as we do our lessons in bare feet in the hall. We are working to keep the staff as safe as possible so would ask you to send children in jogging bottoms or leggings on Thursdays. This will mean that they only need to remove their shoes, socks and jumper for P.E. Also, please remember that jewellery must not be worn for safety reasons.

School lunch

The lunch menu is on our school website. If you feel there is a meal your child would not enjoy you can order a sandwich or a jacket potato for that day. Please order for the week with Mrs Gregory on Monday

mornings. Orders will be taken on the playground or by phone/email at the moment.
