## Maths - Measuring

If you cannot access the lessons, practice adding and taking away:

- Write all the number facts for the number 20. E.g -  $17+3=20$  so  $20-3=17$
- Practice adding a one digit number to any two digit number e.g  $32 + 5$ . Remember to put the bug number if your head and count on.
- Take away a one digit number from a two digit number e.g.  $28 - 4$ . Put the biggest number in your head and count backwards.
