Coming into School each day.....

- Each morning the children will enter school via the downstairs KS1 door. They will be greeted by staff and teachers will be available to speak to. Please pass on any messages you have. We can also collect monies and letters etc. from you each morning.
- We will continue to have **no parents in the classrooms**, as the children are now used to this system. It is also much better for little ones with attachment worries, as it causes less emotional stress.
- Please make sure that your child brings a coat and their book bag into school each day.
- Breakfast is the most important meal of the day. Children cannot function without it. Please make sure they have eaten and had a drink before coming to school. We will then offer them further breakfast if they would like it.
- PE kits should be left on children's pegs for the full half term. They will be sent home at the end of every half for washing.
- **PUNCTUALITY** is essential. Our door closes promptly at 9.00am. Every minute counts!



PE Days

- Key Stage One PE days are **Tuesday** and **Wednesday**.
- Please make sure that earrings are removed on these days as we cannot do this ourselves in school, in line with county policy.
- PE kits consist of only shorts and a t/shirt. The children will need footwear on some occasions throughout the year but if this is the case, we will inform you as and when.
- There are times across the year when we do implement extra PE into our curriculum. For example, swimming in Year 2 in the summer term and training for sports competitions. Again we will keep you informed of these changes.



Snack Money

- Snack money is £1 a week. You are welcome to pay either weekly or for the full half term at once. This pays for the children a special snack each Friday and also covers cookery costs etc.
- Each day the children are given a piece of free fruit which is provided by the government. They are also encouraged to drink plenty of water throughout the day.
- If you would like to upgrade your child's playtime drink from water to milk, please let us know. There is no extra cost for this.

Reading improves lives, it's a fact! Here in Key Stage One we invite you to work with us and help your child to become a life long reader.

Book Bags must be in school every single day.

We also hold **Class Library** each Friday. The children select their own book of choice to take home for that week, returning it the following Friday.

Leaving School each day.....

- The children will exit school from the Hall door, situated near Station Road gate.
- Children will exit school in small groups as and when their adults are spotted. Please bare with us as we get to know you.
- If staff need to speak with you about your child, you will be left until the end or until the majority of pupils have exited.



Attendance Matters

- Please make sure that children are in school everyday, unless they are genuinely ill, or have a medical appointment.
- We cannot catch up on missed learning and we do not want the children to miss out on their education.
