	Learning Objective	Overview	Assessment Questions
Lesson 1	To understand people follow different religions and be respectful about this. Introduction to Christianity.	Children will discuss: who is God? Why is God important to Christians? Children will discuss the questions above and they will write two/three beliefs for a Christian and some will write one question that they would like to find out about Christianity.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Can children recall some of the teachings/beliefs for a Christian? Can children think of a question, something they would like to find out about? Can children compare some of the teachings between a Buddhist and a Christian?
Lesson 2	To learn about The Story of Creation. To interpret and express their own opinion about creation.	Children will listen to The Story of Creation. Discuss how Christians believe the world was created. Children will sequence the story in small groups and then they will write their own beliefs about creation.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Can children retell the religious story? Can children associate emotions and messages to the story? Can children share their beliefs about creation?
Lesson 3	To label a Church. (Visit to the Church)	Children will learn about the place of worship for Christians, and they will find out the names of the different parts and objects inside a Church. Visit to the Church.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Can children recognise and name some of the objects inside the Church? Can children name the sacred text for a Christian? Can children name the place of worship for a Christian?
Lesson 4	To recognise and name religious artefacts,	Children will look at images of a variety of Christian artefacts, including the cross, the Bible, the advent candle, Nativity set, advent wreath. Children will write the name of the artefact. Some children will say why the artefact is important and what it is used for.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Can children recognise some religious artefacts? Can children correctly name the religious artefacts? Can children sort the artefacts into categories?
Lesson 5	To understand how Christmas is celebrated.	Children will discuss how Christmas is celebrated with their family. The children will learn how Buddhists celebrate a special day, Bodhi Day and they will learn how Christians celebrate a special day, Christmas. They will compare and discuss similarities and differences. The children will draw a picture to show how Christmas is celebrated and explain ways how it is celebrated with their family.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Can children compare special things that happen in different families? Can children, make a statement about the similarities and differences? Can children describe and make connections between different celebrations?
Lesson 6	To recap what we have found out about the religion, Christianity.	Children will recall key facts about Christianity.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Can children recall prior learning about Christianity? Can children show what they have understood by expressing their ideas in their own words?
