Attendance and Punctuality

Our whole school attendance continues to be slightly under the Local Authority Target at 93%. Year 1 are in the lead with 94% followed by Reception, Year 2 and then Nursery. Please ensure your child is in school as much as possible to help them achieve their full potential.



Please remember, all children should be in school before the doors close at 9.00am so that the registers can be done and lessons begin on time. **If you arrive after this time you must take your child to the school office so that they can be signed in.** If you are finding it difficult to get to school for 9am don't forget that the morning club is open from 8.00am at a cost of £2 per session.

Please inform us before 09.00am if your child is ill and will not attend school that day. Can we also kindly ask that all absence is reported to the school office via telephone. Staff do not always access Class Dojo in a morning and on occasion messages reporting absence have been missed.

Please remember your order MUST be placed before midnight on Sunday the 7th of August to guarantee it's processed and dispatched in time for back to school.


