* We discussed the pupil's responses to questions 5 and 6. The pupil can sometimes find it difficult to follow routines and is being supported to do so. The pupil was able to articulate why we do jobs (to learn) and what rewards are given for completing tasks. They agree that they should try hard to join in with all activities in school.

*Question 6 was discussed with the 3 pupils. The first pupil articulated that on one occasion, a peer pupil was unkind but could explain the consequences of that behaviour and was happy that it was dealt with fairly by staff. The second pupil was also questioned on response 6. They said that they like to be at home watching TV. We discussed the things that the pupil does enjoy doing at school and plenty was mentioned. We also discussed the importance of coming to school to learn each day. The third pupil talked about getting angry with friends when they don't want to play his games. We discussed everybody's right to choose and solutions to that problem.
